Egypt has reaffirmed its position against any plan to forcibly transfer Palestinians into Sinai.

Meanwhile, Israel continues to widen the so-called “yellow line” inside the Strip, deepening concerns over creeping territorial encroachment despite the ceasefire framework.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 70,112 and injured 171,015 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.
