Al-Qassam Brigades released footage of its August 20 raid on a newly built Israeli military site southeast of Khan Yunis, saying it inflicted casualties in a prolonged clash that Israel later said resembled the October 7 attack.

Meanwhile, US President Donald Trump said there is “a real opportunity to achieve great accomplishments in the Middle East.”

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 66,055 and injured 168,346 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

- “We can achieve the impossible when we stand shoulder to shoulder with the United States.”

## **Trump: We Are Approaching a Historic Solution and Will Announce Eternal Peace in the Middle East**

US PRESIDENT DONALD TRUMP:

US President Donald Trump declared that the world is now “on the verge of solving an old problem,” referring to efforts to end the war in Gaza.

He added that his message was no longer just about stopping the war in Gaza, but about achieving “eternal peace in the Middle East.”

Trump explained that he discussed with Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu ways to end the war in Gaza, and that he would soon announce comprehensive principles to achieve peace in the region.

He expressed gratitude to Arab and Muslim leaders, as well as European allies, for their positive response to the US principles, and thanked Netanyahu for agreeing to the peace plan.

She also stated that Trump would speak with Qatar, which has played a distinguished mediating role between Washington and Hamas. “We hope Hamas and Israel will agree on a plan to end the war, and this is what the president expects and hopes for,” she concluded.

## **Diplomatic Push for Gaza Deal Intensifies Ahead of Trump-Netanyahu Meeting**

### **Near Agreement:**

An Israeli official told Yedioth Ahronoth that there is a “good atmosphere” and “significant progress” toward a Gaza deal, claiming they are “very close” to reaching understandings after several drafts and amendments to the wording.

### **Hamas Approval Key:**

A White House official told Axios after the talks with Netanyahu that while they are very close to agreeing on President Trump's plan, Hamas's official approval is still necessary and has not been secured yet.

### **Netanyahu's Conditions Narrowing:**

The Times of Israel reported that Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's conditions for accepting the proposal relate mainly to the disarming of Hamas and the Palestinian Authority's (PA) role in Gaza after the war. US envoy Witkoff worked to overcome Netanyahu's objections. Haaretz also reported that differences between the two sides regarding the Trump plan are now narrowing.

### **Captive Families' Appeal:**

Israeli hostage families addressed a direct message to US President Donald Trump ahead of his scheduled meeting with Netanyahu at the White House, writing: "You alone have the power to push this deal to the finish line."

## **News Roundup: Israeli Strikes on Refugee Tents and Residential Homes; Trump Proposal Discussed**

### **Strike on Displaced People:**

Al-Awda Hospital reported one Palestinian killed and several injuries following an Israeli strike on a tent sheltering displaced people north of the Nuseirat refugee camp in central Gaza.

### **Gaza City Strike:**

Casualties were reported following an Israeli strike that targeted a residential house in the Al-Sabra neighborhood, south of Gaza City.

### **Nuseirat Targeted:**

Israeli aircraft also launched a separate strike on the Nuseirat refugee camp.

### **Netanyahu Discusses Trump's Plan:**

Republican Senator Lindsey Graham expressed hope for an agreement to end the war in Gaza, stating that such a deal must achieve key objectives: Ensure the security that Israel needs and the peace that Palestinians hope for; guarantee the release of all hostages; ensure that Hamas "never returns to power."

## **Trump Optimistic on Gaza Deal; Missile Fired from Yemen Intercepted**

### **Trump Expresses Optimism:**

US President Donald Trump told NBC that he is optimistic about the possibility of reaching a deal to end the war in Gaza. He added that there appears to be a golden opportunity to achieve peace in the Middle East and we are doing well.

### **Netanyahu Meets with Advisors:**

Israel Hayom reported the conclusion of a meeting lasting over six hours between Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu and advisors Witkoff and Kushner, which centered on outlining plans to end the war.

### **Israeli Skepticism on Plan:**

Bloomberg reported that a senior Israeli official described some of the points circulating regarding President Trump's plan to end the war in Gaza as "trial balloons," suggesting they are tentative ideas rather than firm commitments.

### **Missile Fired from Yemen:**

The Israeli army confirmed detecting a missile launch from Yemen and successfully intercepting one missile, which triggered sirens in several Israeli areas. Following the incident, takeoff and landing operations at Ben Gurion Airport were temporarily halted.

### **West Bank Incursions:**

Israeli forces launched raids into the city of Ramallah and the town of Al-Yamoun in the northern part of Jenin in the occupied West Bank.

### **Intense Strikes in Gaza City:**

A violent fire belt (a sustained, heavy bombardment) targeted the vicinity of Al-Shifa Hospital in Gaza City. An Israeli airstrike also destroyed a residential building in the Al-Nasser neighborhood, west of the city.

### **Rafah Shelling:**

Palestinian sources reported ongoing artillery shelling targeting the western areas of Rafah in the southern Gaza Strip.

### **West Bank Incursions:**

Israeli occupation forces conducted raids on two Palestinian refugee camps in the southern West Bank:

Al-Arroub refugee camp, north of Hebron.

Dheisheh refugee camp, south of Bethlehem.

### **Israeli Hospitals on High Alert:**

The Israeli news website Walla reported that the Israeli Ministry of Health has notified hospitals to raise their alert status in preparation for the potential arrival of the “Flotilla of Resilience,” due to fears of possible casualties.
