Israeli airstrikes continued across the Gaza Strip, killing additional Palestinians, including one in the Zaytoun neighborhood.

At the same time, Israeli occupation forces carried out extensive raids and arrests throughout the occupied West Bank, amid reports of an intensified search for the remains of an Israeli captive in northern Gaza.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 70,103 and injured 170,985 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.
