Iranian armed forces have launched a retaliatory operation, dubbed Annunciation of Victory, targeting a US base in Qatar. The operation comes in response to recent US airstrikes on key Iranian nuclear facilities.

Meanwhile, Israeli strikes kill displaced civilians in Khan Yunis and beyond, as aid blockades and bombardment fuel Gaza's catastrophe.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 56,077 and injured 131,848 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

# Major Explosions Rock Tehran and Karaj Amidst Ceasefire Announcement and Israeli Warning

IRANIAN MEDIA, ISRAELI MEDIA: Tehran and the city of Karaj, west of the Iranian capital, experienced the largest explosions in 12 days tonight, according to Iranian news outlet Nournews. This comes concurrently with US President Donald Trump's announcement of a "temporary ceasefire" agreement between Tehran and Tel Aviv.

Earlier, the Israeli army issued a warning to residents in two areas of Tehran, instructing them to "evacuate their homes immediately." The warning did not specify the nature of the threat or the exact targeted areas, raising concerns about an imminent strike or undeclared military operations deep within Iran.

Simultaneously with the Israeli warning, Iranian media reported the activation of air defense systems in Tehran and in the northern cities of Rasht and Urmia. Local reports indicated unusual movements of interceptor aircraft.

In addition to the explosions in Karaj, Iranian media also reported multiple explosions heard in central and northeastern Tehran, with Fars news agency stating that air defense systems were operating intensely.
