For several days, leaks about the proposal had circulated in the media, mostly attributed to anonymous US officials. On Monday, the White House finally revealed its main bullet points.

Meanwhile, Israeli forces continued their attacks across the Gaza Strip, striking civilian infrastructure and hospitals.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 66,055 and injured 168,346 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

He expressed hope that all parties would view the plan constructively and seize the opportunity to end the war. He added that Hamas has not yet responded, as the plan requires consensus with other factions.

He said the Trump plan achieves the main goal of ending the war, though some issues require clarification and negotiation. Qatar made clear to Hamas that its priority is ending the war, famine, killings, and displacement in Gaza.

According to the statement, the fighters opened fire at point-blank range, killing and wounding Israeli soldiers. They also threw stun explosives inside two Israeli armored personnel carriers, killing and wounding their crews.

The group said they detonated a Merkava tank with an "al-Amal al-Fida'i" explosive device and observed Israeli helicopters landing to evacuate casualties.

International Reactions:

Western and some Arab and Muslim leaders and regional partners have expressed strong support for US President Donald Trump's new initiative to end the war in Gaza:

The President of the European Council and the Foreign Ministers of Germany and Turkey all welcomed the plan, with the German FM calling it a "historic opportunity." The Palestinian Authority also welcomed the efforts, expressing confidence in Trump's ability to find a path to peace.

Call for Hamas Agreement:

The Prime Minister of the Netherlands and UK Prime Minister Keir Starmer urged Hamas to approve the Trump plan, with Starmer explicitly calling on the group to lay down its arms and release all remaining detainees.

Massacres in Gaza City:

Casualties, including both deaths and missing persons, were reported after an Israeli airstrike targeted a residential house in the Al-Sabra neighborhood, south of the city.

Five people were reported wounded after an Israeli drone strike targeted a house north of the Nuseirat refugee camp.

Israeli forces raided the village of Beit Iba, west of Nablus, in the occupied West Bank.

Flotilla Resumes Journey:

The Global Flotilla of Resilience resumed its journey toward the Gaza coast after a several-hour delay caused by technical faults on three of its vessels.

Anticipating Interception:

The fleet is now approximately 305 nautical miles from Gaza's shores. Participants are preparing to cross the "Orange Zone," where they anticipate the Israeli Navy will attempt to intercept them in the coming days.

Israel will not occupy or annex Gaza.

The Israeli army will gradually withdraw in favor of a temporary international stabilization force.

This force will deploy immediately in Gaza, train and support Palestinian police, and oversee a disarmament process under independent monitors.

Humanitarian aid will be delivered and distributed via the United Nations and the Red Crescent.

Reconstruction will be overseen by an expert committee.

Guarantees will be provided to ensure Hamas and other factions meet commitments, with none playing a role in governing Gaza.

No one will be forced to leave Gaza, and those who depart voluntarily will have the right to return.
