The concluding statement of the Arab-Islamic summit in Doha on Monday urged member states to reconsider their diplomatic and economic ties with Israel and to pursue legal measures against it.

Meanwhile, Israeli forces detonated a vehicle packed with explosives to demolish residential buildings northwest of Gaza City.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 64,964 and injured 165,312 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

Intensified Attacks:

The Israeli military has intensified its air and ground assaults on Gaza, accompanied by the demolition of residential buildings in the northern part of the city. Palestinian sources report that an Israeli strike on a home in the Al-Sabra neighborhood killed 4 people, while another strike on a residential apartment in the Deir al-Balah camp killed 3.

Local sources reported that Israeli artillery shelled central Khan Yunis. In northern Gaza, Israeli helicopters opened fire on homes in the Sheikh Radwan neighborhood. There is also heavy Israeli drone activity at low altitudes over the Al-Bureij camp.

According to Israel's Channel 12, the security cabinet believes the ground operation in Gaza will conclude by the end of this year. An Israeli security source also told the channel that around 320,000 residents of Gaza City have been evacuated, a number that allows for the start of the ground operation. The chief of staff held a final meeting yesterday ahead of the anticipated invasion.

US Secretary of State's Statement:

US Secretary of State Marco Rubio said the war in Gaza has gone on "long enough." He called on Hamas to immediately release all hostages, both living and deceased.

Hamas Responds to Trump:

Hamas strongly condemned US President Donald Trump's statements on the Gaza war and the hostages, calling them a "blatant bias towards Zionist propaganda." Hamas accused Netanyahu of intentionally destroying every chance for a ceasefire agreement and a prisoner release, and it held Washington responsible for the war's escalation.

Recognizing Palestine:

The newspaper Politico reports that Luxembourg intends to recognize the state of Palestine, with a final decision expected later this month.
