The UN has warned that heavy rains could worsen already catastrophic conditions in Gaza, where hundreds of thousands remain displaced with little shelter or infrastructure.

Meanwhile, Israeli occupation forces killed a Palestinian during raids in the occupied West Bank, as military operations and settler violence continue across multiple areas.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 70,667 and injured 171,151 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.
