Gaza's already dire humanitarian conditions continue to deteriorate, with hospitals overwhelmed, displacement rising, and shortages of food, water, and medical supplies reaching critical levels.

At the same time, Israeli forces have intensified raids across the occupied West Bank, resulting in new killings, injuries, and arrests.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 69,176 and injured 170,690 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

News Roundup: Seven Casualties in Gaza; Israeli Demolition in Jerusalem; US Envoys Due to Arrive

Seven Casualties Reported in 24 Hours:

The Gaza Ministry of Health reported that hospitals received 7 people killed over the past 24 hours, including one new casualty and 6 recovered from under the rubble, in addition to 5 injuries.

The Ministry stressed that a number of victims remain under the rubble and on the roads, making access difficult for ambulance and civil defense teams.

The total number of casualties since the ceasefire began on October 11, 2025, is 241 killed and 619 injured, with 528 bodies recovered from under the rubble.

The overall toll since October 7, 2023, has risen to 69,176 killed and 170,690 injured.

Netanyahu Expects Body Repatriation:

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu stated during a government session that Israel expects to receive the body of Captain Hadar Goldin this afternoon.

Israeli Home Demolition:

Israeli forces demolished a house in the West Bank town of Brugin, west of Salfit.

Settlers Attack Vehicles:

Settlers attacked Palestinian vehicles in the village of Al-Maniya, southeast of Bethlehem.

Incursion in Hebron:

Israeli forces raided the town of Beit Ummar, north of Hebron, conducting searches and raids.

Settler Violence as Annexation Policy:

The Euro-Med Human Rights Monitor stated that the escalation of settler attacks, documented at 324 incidents over 39 days resulting in 143 injuries and damage to 4,200 trees, occurs under Israeli army protection and aims to impose de facto annexation and displacement.

Jerusalem Land Demolition:

Israeli municipal crews in Jerusalem bulldozed land in Airport Street to construct a new road without prior warning, destroying a commercial facility that included mobile offices and a bus stop.

US Envoys Arriving:

Israeli Public Broadcasting reported that US Envoys Steve Witkoff and Jared Kushner will arrive tomorrow for a visit aimed at resolving the crisis of Hamas fighters in the Rafah area and following up on the implementation of the ceasefire plan.

Netanyahu Seeks Postponement:

The Israeli newspaper Israel Hayom reported that Prime Minister Netanyahu requested the cancellation of his scheduled testimony tomorrow in his corruption trial due to "emergency" political meetings.
