UNICEF warns Gaza has entered famine, as hunger and Israel's controversial aid scheme leave over 1,400 Palestinians dead and tens of thousands more injured or displaced.

Abu Obeida said the Qassam Brigades would allow Red Cross aid to Israeli captives if Israel ends airstrikes and opens Gaza crossings.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 60,933 and injured 150,027 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

We need safe corridors to deliver aid. Many types of food have been unavailable in Gaza for months.

"Humanitarian corridors must be permanently opened to allow food and medicine across Gaza.
