Israeli Defense Minister Israel Katz and Chief of Staff Eyal Zamir reportedly approved plans to occupy Gaza City as the Israeli army decided to bring forward the call-up of 50,000 reserve soldiers.

Meanwhile, Palestinian resistance groups in Gaza continue to document their destruction of Israeli military vehicles, while Egyptian sources deny Israeli media claims of a proposal to disarm Hamas.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 62,122 and injured 156,758 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

## **Yisrael Hayom: Soldiers Dying from Heat Inside Armored Vehicles in Gaza**

ISRAEL HAYOM: Israeli soldiers are dying from extreme heat inside armored vehicles in the Gaza Strip. Soldiers reported repeated malfunctions in air conditioning systems inside armored vehicles. As a result, temperatures inside the vehicles can reach up to 60°C. Soldiers face three difficult choices: to literally die from heat, to continue fighting with the vehicle open which exposes them to extreme danger, or to withdraw from the battle. The army admits that using armored vehicles with broken air conditioning systems contradicts official regulations. Many soldiers continue to fight in open conditions despite the risks.

Tajani stressed that Italy opposes “the occupation of Gaza and parts of the West Bank through settlements, as well as Israeli attacks on Christians,” adding that Italy’s goal is the establishment of a Palestinian state.

He expressed readiness to send Italian troops under a UN mission led by Arab countries to help build the Palestinian state.
