Despite US President Donald Trump's announcement of a ceasefire, Israeli airstrikes and shelling continued across Gaza, killing scores and targeting schools and aid lines.

Limited humanitarian aid has entered the Strip, but conditions remain catastrophic.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 56,331 and injured 132,632 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

According to these intelligence evaluations, Iran's 408-kilogram stockpile of enriched uranium was not solely located at the Fordow facility but was distributed across various other sites.

Khan Yunis Ambush Sparks Israeli Outrage as Resistance Operations Expand
