

Despite the ceasefire, Israeli forces continue large-scale demolitions and bombardments across Gaza, killing three Palestinians and worsening an already dire humanitarian situation.

Meanwhile, Hezbollah's Sheikh Naim Qassem accused the US of enabling Israeli violations of Lebanese sovereignty, affirming that Lebanon's people, not foreign powers, are its true sovereigns and vowing readiness to defend the country if attacked.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 68,858 and injured 170,664 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.
