Israeli forces continued their military operations across the Gaza Strip on Monday, with air and artillery strikes reported in several areas under bombardment.

### Palestinian Factions Reject US Draft Resolution on Gaza

#### PALESTINIAN FACTIONS:

Palestinian factions and political forces issued a joint statement warning:

- The US draft resolution at the UN Security Council poses a dangerous attempt to impose international trusteeship on Gaza.
- · Any international force must operate solely under a UN mandate and in coordination with official Palestinian institutions.
- Its role must be limited to protecting civilians, ensuring the flow of humanitarian aid, and separating forces.
- · Any foreign military presence or international bases in Gaza constitutes a violation of Palestinian sovereignty.
- The proposed Arab-Islamic model for administering Gaza is the most acceptable framework.
- They reject any clause related to disarming Gaza or undermining the right of the Palestinian people to resist.
- · Any discussions about weapons must remain a national matter tied to a political process that guarantees the end of occupation.
- The current US draft paves the way for external control over Palestinian decision-making and reconstruction.
- · Humanitarian and reconstruction efforts must be implemented through competent Palestinian institutions under UN supervision.
