Israeli occupation forces launched widespread attacks on displaced Palestinians across Gaza on Saturday, leaving scores dead. At the same time, three of the few hospitals still operating in the Strip were forced out of service.

While commemorating the first anniversary of the passing of two of its most prominent leaders, Sayyed Hassan Nasrallah and Sayyed Hashem Safi al-Din, Sheikh Qassem emphasized that while Hezbollah remains committed to national unity, this unity must be focused on shared defense against the external enemy.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 65,926 and injured 167,783 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

An immediate halt to all military operations and a freezing of current battle lines.

The release of all detainees within 48 hours.

The destruction of all offensive weapons belonging to Hamas.

Granting amnesty to militants who commit to peaceful coexistence.

Nablus Raids:

Israeli forces launched incursions into neighborhoods and several villages across the Nablus governorate. Local sources reported that forces used sound bombs during a raid on the Old Askar Refugee Camp and also conducted raids in the Al-Juneid area west of Nablus.

Participants:

The flotilla carries approximately 60 people representing 15 different nationalities, including French and other European parliamentarians.

Destination and Alliance:

The new fleet, launched by the Freedom Flotilla Coalition and "Thousand Madelines," is expected to join the existing "Flotilla of Resilience" which is currently off the coast of the Greek island of Crete.

Context:

The Flotilla of Resilience already comprises more than 50 boats and hundreds of activists from around 45 countries, with some of its ships having set sail from Catania earlier this month on September 13.
