Israel renewed its attacks on Gaza, killing several Palestinians and citing alleged Hamas ceasefire violations, despite mediators confirming the delays in body recoveries are due to the devastation caused by Israel's own bombings.

The renewed Israeli aggression followed threats against the Palestinian Resistance movement Hamas by Israeli Defense Minister Israel Katz, who warned of a "high price" for an alleged attack targeting Israeli soldiers in Gaza.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 68,527 and injured 170,395 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

Heavy Bombing and Breaches:

Israeli naval vessels and tanks continued shelling the coast and Al-Mawasi area of Rafah, while air raids renewed across various locations in Gaza City and Khan Yunis, marking new violations of the ceasefire agreement.

Overnight Casualties:

Hospital sources reported the death of 18 Palestinians and injuries to at least 50 in Israeli raids across Gaza City and Khan Younis.

Specific Targets and Victims

Khan Yunis:

Nasser Medical Complex announced the death of a child in a bombing that targeted a residential apartment in the Al-Amal neighborhood.

Gaza City:

Three others, including a young girl, were killed in a raid on a home in the Yarmouk area. Civil defense teams later recovered the bodies of four more victims from under the rubble of the Al-Banna family home in the Al-Sabra neighborhood.

Rescue Efforts Hampered:

Eyewitnesses reported that rescue teams face significant difficulties retrieving the missing due to the continuous shelling and the presence of Israeli warplanes in the Strip's airspace.

Israel's Intent and Warning to Hamas:

Israeli Channel 12 quoted a senior official stating that the strikes in Gaza are not intended to collapse the ceasefire but to ensure its implementation, adding that Hamas "must fear the return of war."

US Pressure on Netanyahu:

The channel revealed that US President Donald Trump's advisors pressured Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu to avoid excessive reactions that could ignite the truce, while also proposing a "harsher American warning" be issued to Hamas.

Turkey Condemns Attacks:

Turkey strongly condemned the recent Israeli attacks, describing them as a "clear violation of the existing ceasefire" between Hamas and Tel Aviv.

US Expects Israeli Response:

US Vice President JD Vance stated that the United States expects an Israeli response after an attack targeted an Israeli soldier inside Gaza, though he affirmed the ceasefire is currently holding.

Qassam Brigades Delays Body Handover:

The Qassam Brigades announced the postponement of handing over the body of an Israeli captive found in a tunnel in Khan Yunis.

Reason for Delay:

The Brigades warned that the Israeli violations "hinder search, excavation, and retrieval operations" and cautioned that any new escalation will lead to further delays in handing over the bodies of killed Israelis.

Fear of Renewed War:

With the continuation of shelling and the rising number of victims, Gaza residents fear that the current night's events may be a prelude to the collapse of the truce and a return to open warfare.
