The Israeli army has intensified its systematic targeting of high-rise buildings, residential complexes and vital facilities in Gaza City, as it prepares to occupy the city.

Meanwhile, according to UN Security Council sources, the ten elected member states are pushing for a vote on a draft resolution demanding a permanent ceasefire in Gaza.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 65,062 and injured 165,697 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

AL-JAZEERA: Israeli forces demolished residential buildings in both northern and southern Gaza.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Al-Awda Hospital in Nuseirat reported 4 deaths and 10 injuries after Israeli aircraft struck a house in Al-Bureij refugee camp.

Airstrike on Refugee Camp:

Palestinian media reports that an Israeli airstrike on a home belonging to the Abu Khair family in the Al-Bureij refugee camp has resulted in multiple casualties and injuries.

Palestinian Student to be Deported:

Reuters reports that a US judge has ordered the deportation of Mahmoud Khalil, a Palestinian graduate student at Columbia University, to either Algeria or Syria. Khalil was a prominent leader of the student protests against the Israeli war on Gaza. He had been held by immigration authorities for over three months before being released on bail, pending the completion of his permanent residency revocation.

UN Documents Prisoner Deaths:

The UN Human Rights Office in the occupied Palestinian territories has documented the deaths of at least 75 Palestinians in Israeli detention facilities between October 2023 and the end of August 2025. Of these, 49 were from the Gaza Strip, 24 from the West Bank, and two were Palestinian citizens of Israel. The report stated that Israeli authorities have deliberately imposed detention conditions amounting to torture, which contributed to the deaths of the detainees.

Trump-Netanyahu Relationship:

The Wall Street Journal reports that a senior Israeli official claims the relationship between Prime Minister Netanyahu and Donald Trump is “excellent,” and any reports to the contrary are “fake news.”

News Roundup: Casualties in Gaza and West Bank Raids

Airstrikes on a Residential Area:

Palestinian media reports that an Israeli airstrike on a residential block in the Sheikh Radwan neighborhood in northern Gaza City has resulted in several casualties, including women and children.

Widespread Communication Outage:

The Palestinian Telecommunications Company announced that landline and fixed internet services have been cut off in the governorates of Gaza and North Gaza.

Armored Vehicle Detonation:

Palestinian media has circulated footage showing the Israeli army detonating a booby-trapped armored vehicle among homes in northwestern Gaza City.

Widespread Raids and Arrests:

Israeli occupation forces conducted a series of raids and arrests in several locations across the West Bank. These included Kafr Aqab and Jabal al-Mukaber in occupied Jerusalem, as well as the area around Qalandia camp.

Also, in the West Bank, raids took place in the towns of Surra and Awarta near Nablus, Sa’ir and the southern part of Hebron, Deir al-Ghusun near Tulkarem, and Kafr Ni’ma near Ramallah.

Clashes in Tubas:

Israeli forces also entered the city of Tubas, where local media reported that Palestinian resistance fighters opened fire on the soldiers.

West Bank Raids, Gaza Demolitions, and Global Solidarity

Gaza Attacks:

Local media reports that Israeli forces have shelled the area around the General Security headquarters in northern Gaza City. The Israeli army also reportedly demolished homes in western Gaza City, near the Sheikh Radwan Pond and the Al-Maqousi Towers.

West Bank Raids:

Israeli occupation forces raided two towns west of Hebron: Idhna and Beit Awwa. During the incursion into Beit Awwa, forces reportedly fired tear gas canisters at some homes.

London Charity Concert:

A charity concert titled “Together for Palestine” was held at the Wembley Arena in London. The event featured a wide range of international artists and a large audience, with proceeds supporting humanitarian relief efforts for Palestinians in the Gaza Strip. The concert aims to protest the “war of extermination and starvation” that Gaza has been subjected to for nearly two years.

Gaza Genocide Death Toll Surpasses 65,000

GAZA HEALTH MINISTRY: The Gaza Health Ministry reported that 98 Palestinians were killed and 385 wounded in the past 24 hours amid ongoing Israeli attacks. Four more Palestinians, including two children, died from starvation, raising the total deaths from Israeli-enforced famine to 432 since October 7, 2023. The overall toll from Israel’s genocide has now reached 65,062 killed and 165,697 wounded.
