Israeli forces have renewed airstrikes on several areas across the Gaza Strip, despite the ongoing ceasefire agreement.

At the same time, military activity along the Lebanese border has intensified, signaling a potential widening of the Israeli aggression.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 69,756 and injured 170,946 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.
