Israel bombed the Hamas negotiating delegation during a meeting in Doha on Tuesday. A leading Hamas source told Al-Jazeera that Israel targeted the negotiating delegation during a meeting in the Qatari capital to discuss US President Donald Trump's proposal for a ceasefire in the Gaza Strip.

Hamas, however, denied that its leadership had been eliminated. According to a senior source in the movement who spoke to Al-Jazeera, the Hamas leadership delegation — headed by Khalil al-Hayya — survived the Israeli assassination attempt in Doha.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 64,656 and injured 163,503 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

starvation of Gaza must not be used as a tool of war, and it must stop. We will establish a donor group for the Palestinians next month and a dedicated mechanism for Gaza's reconstruction.”
