Israel has intensified its bombardment on southern Gaza overnight, as reports emerge of renewed attacks in residential areas beyond the yellow line.

Meanwhile, in the occupied West Bank, a Palestinian has been killed amid ongoing raids and escalating violence by Israeli forces.

.Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 69,187 and injured 170,703 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

Palestinian Factions Reject US Draft Resolution on Gaza

PALESTINIAN FACTIONS:

Palestinian factions and political forces issued a joint statement warning:

The US draft resolution at the UN Security Council poses a dangerous attempt to impose international trusteeship on Gaza.

Any international force must operate solely under a UN mandate and in coordination with official Palestinian institutions.

Its role must be limited to protecting civilians, ensuring the flow of humanitarian aid, and separating forces.

Any foreign military presence or international bases in Gaza constitutes a violation of Palestinian sovereignty.

The proposed Arab-Islamic model for administering Gaza is the most acceptable framework.

They reject any clause related to disarming Gaza or undermining the right of the Palestinian people to resist.

Any discussions about weapons must remain a national matter tied to a political process that guarantees the end of occupation.

The current US draft paves the way for external control over Palestinian decision-making and reconstruction.

Humanitarian and reconstruction efforts must be implemented through competent Palestinian institutions under UN supervision.
