The Al-Qassam Brigades announced a multi-phased operation against a newly established Israeli military position in southern Gaza, while Israeli media acknowledged a "significant" attack and troop casualties.

Meanwhile, Israeli Defense Minister Israel Katz and Chief of Staff Eyal Zamir approved plans to occupy Gaza City.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 62,122 and injured 156,758 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

## Al-Qassam Brigades Target Israeli Soldiers and Vehicles on Salah al-Din Axis

AL-QASSAM BRIGADES: The Al-Qassam Brigades continued their field operations, announcing on Thursday that they targeted a gathering of Israeli soldiers and vehicles on the Salah al-Din axis with short-range Rajoum rockets. This marks the second announcement today from the brigades, which earlier said they struck a command-and-control site and a gathering of soldiers and vehicles west of Rafah, in southern Gaza.

## United Nations Reveals Israel's Refusal to Allow Monitors at Gaza Crossings

UNITED NATIONS: A deputy spokesperson for UN Secretary-General António Guterres said Israel has refused the UN request to deploy monitors at Gaza crossings, all of which are under Israeli control. The official added that this refusal prevents the UN from independently verifying the

volume of aid entering Gaza. The UN also reported that Israel bombed a displaced persons site near an OCHA facility in Deir al-Balah.

"They constitute also an affront against the Court's States Parties, the rules-based international order and, above all, millions of innocent victims across the world."

# 21 European States Condemn Israeli Settlements

#### 1.3 Million at Risk If Israel Invades Gaza
