The Families of Israeli Captives Committee announced that more than one million people participated today in protests and demonstrations across Israel.

Meanwhile, heavy Israeli artillery shelling targeted the Al-Sabra neighborhood south of Gaza City, while additional bombardments struck residential areas in Rafah and Khan Yunis in southern Gaza.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 62,004 and injured 156,230 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.
