Meanwhile, Israeli forces unleashed intense bombardment on Gaza City and Khan Yunis on Tuesday, killing at least 22 Palestinians, including children, as nearly 900,000 remain trapped under siege.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 65,419 and injured 167,160 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

Rising Death Toll in Gaza:

Medical sources report that 29 Palestinians have been killed in Israeli airstrikes across the Gaza Strip since dawn today, with 24 of the deaths occurring in Gaza City.

West Bank Incursions:

Israeli forces are carrying out raids in the West Bank. They have continued their incursion into the Al-Marah neighborhood in the city of Jenin and also raided the town of Ya'bad to the south. Near Ramallah, Israeli forces raided homes during an incursion into the town of Turmus Ayya.

Drone Attacks:

An Al-Jazeera correspondent reported that at least 10 ships from the "Global Flotilla of Resilience," a convoy aiming to break the blockade on Gaza, came under drone attack in the Mediterranean Sea early Wednesday. Explosions were heard, but there are no confirmed reports of damage to the ships or human casualties.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: A source at the Baptist Hospital reports that an Israeli airstrike early this morning on displaced people near the Firas market in central Gaza City resulted in the death of 17 people, including children.

Israeli Strike in Gaza Kills Four, as Boats Come Under Attack

Casualties in Nuseirat:

The Civil Defense in Gaza announced that it has retrieved the bodies of four Palestinians after an Israeli airstrike targeted a home in Camp 1 in the Nuseirat refugee camp early this morning.

Iraqi President at the UN:

In a speech at the UN General Assembly, Iraqi President Abdel Latif Rashid condemned Israel's actions as "morally intolerable." He called on the international community to take a decisive stance against Israeli settlement plans and policies.

President Rashid also condemned Israel's attacks on regional countries, specifically mentioning Syria, Lebanon, and most recently, Qatar, stating that the attack on Qatar was a "blatant violation of its sovereignty."

Flotilla Updates:

The "Global Flotilla of Resilience" accused Israel of launching a disinformation campaign to justify a potential military attack against it.

The group reported that over the past 24 hours, more than 15 drones have flown over its boat, the "Alma," and that there have been 13 explosions and widespread communication jamming.

The flotilla also stated that unidentified objects were dropped on 10 of its boats, causing damage. The group warned that any attack on the humanitarian convoy would be a "war crime."

News Roundup: Israeli Attacks on Gaza Kill Displaced Civilians; Flotilla Attacked by Drones

Massacre of Displaced Civilians:

Palestinian sources report that the death toll from an Israeli airstrike on a building sheltering displaced people near Firas Market in Gaza City has risen to 20, including children.

Another Israeli airstrike on a home in the Nuseirat refugee camp killed four people from a single family.

Ongoing Genocide:

Israeli forces are carrying out raids in Gaza City, with both warplanes and helicopters conducting airstrikes and firing intensely on western neighborhoods like Al-Nasser. Sound bombs were also used over the Al-Nasser and Tal al-Hawa neighborhoods.

Hospitals Cease Operations:

The Director-General of the World Health Organization (WHO), Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus, stated that the rising Israeli violence has forced Al-Rantisi Children's Hospital and the Eye Hospital in Gaza to cease operations.

He highlighted that Al-Rantisi was the only specialized children's hospital in Gaza, and the Eye Hospital was the only facility offering specialized eye care.

G7 Calls for Aid:

In a joint statement, foreign ministers from the G7 nations called for urgent action to alleviate the "immense suffering of civilians in Gaza."

Drone Attacks:

A spokesperson for the "Global Flotilla of Resilience" confirmed that 12 drone attacks targeted nine of its ships in the Mediterranean Sea.

The UN Special Rapporteur for Human Rights in Palestine, Francesca Albanese, also confirmed seven drone attacks on the fleet's ships.

Colombian President Condemns Genocide:

Colombian President Gustavo Petro strongly condemned the Israeli violence in Gaza, stating that "it is a genocide and we must prevent it." He accused Donald Trump of allowing missiles to be fired at children, women, and the elderly in Gaza.

Intense Strikes in Gaza:

Palestinian sources report that Israeli warplanes launched airstrikes on Gaza City early Wednesday morning. Helicopters and drones are also continuously firing on western neighborhoods, including Al-Nasser.

Israeli forces have also demolished homes in the Sheikh Radwan and Al-Jalaa neighborhoods using explosives and carried out artillery shelling north of the Nuseirat refugee camp.

Planned Escalation:

Israel's Channel 13 reported that the army is planning to send additional forces to Gaza City to increase pressure on the Palestinian Resistance.

The Chief of Staff, Eyal Zamir, reportedly believes that military pressure can be converted into a political solution, and the operation is designed to be halted at any stage to achieve a deal.

West Bank Raids:

Israeli forces raided the city of Al-Bireh and the town of Za'atara, east of Bethlehem.

In the Hebron area, forces used sound bombs during a raid on Wadi al-Samman.

Trump Meets with Arab and Muslim Leaders:

A meeting between US President Donald Trump and leaders from several Arab and Muslim nations—including Turkey, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, the UAE, Indonesia, Egypt, Jordan, and Pakistan—has concluded. The discussion focused on ways to end the war in Gaza, and Trump described the talks as "great" and "very fruitful."

Global Support for Two-State Solution:

In his address to the UN, French President Emmanuel Macron stated that 142 countries have shown support for a two-state solution.

Lebanon's Demands:

Lebanese President Joseph Aoun called on Israel to immediately stop its attacks, withdraw from Lebanese territory, and release Lebanese prisoners.
