In response to Witkoff's claims, Hamas issued a categorical denial, stating that it has no intention of disarming.

Meanwhile, scores of Palestinians were killed or injured on Saturday, as Israeli forces targeted the tents of displaced people, civilian homes, and people waiting for aid across the Gaza Strip, amid the Israeli army's ongoing demolition of neighborhoods.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 60,430 and injured 148,722 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

The army reportedly does not understand what the political leadership wants and warned that continuing the mission will result in negative consequences. There is "enormous exhaustion" in frontline army units, and extending the war will have long-term effects on the troops.
