#### Death Toll from Israeli Genocide in Gaza Continues to Rise

#### **GAZA HEALTH MINISTRY:**

The Ministry of Health in Gaza announced that the death toll from Israel's genocide since October 2023 has risen to 69,756 martyrs and 170,946 wounded.

According to the ministry's daily statistical update, hospitals received 23 martyrs over the past 24 hours — including 21 newly killed and two recovered from beneath the rubble — along with 83 injured Palestinians.

The statement added that since October 11, Israel has killed 339 Palestinians and wounded 871 during ongoing violations of the ceasefire.
