Israel's war on Gaza and its escalation across the occupied West Bank continue, with reports of three Israeli soldiers injured in a stabbing operation in Ramallah.

Meanwhile, Israeli forces killed a Palestinian child in Hebron and intensified artillery shelling on Khan Yunis in southern Gaza.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 70,103 and injured 170,985 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

Tel Aviv continues to condition the launch of negotiations for the second phase of the ceasefire agreement on receiving all bodies of Israeli captives, while Gaza's Government Media Office states that 9,500 Palestinians remain missing under the rubble, killed during Israel's ongoing war of extermination.

The attacks come amid escalating Israeli military operations and settler violence targeting Palestinians, their property, and their livelihoods.

Israeli Occupation Forces Impose Curfew in Qabatiya

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: The Qabatiya municipality confirmed that Israeli forces imposed a full curfew on the town starting Tuesday afternoon and lasting until further notice. Qabatiya has historically been a center of Palestinian resistance, from the era of Izz al-Din al-Qassam to the First and Second Intifadas and recent armed operations.

Mansour Safadi received a sentence of nine and a half years, while Muhammad Salaymeh received eight years. The two were reportedly subjected to lengthy and harsh interrogation.

Israeli Forces Raid Hospitals in Hebron After Vehicle-Ramming Operation

AL-JAZEERA: Israeli forces stormed Al-Ahli Hospital and surrounded Al-Mezan Hospital in Hebron in search of the Palestinian accused of carrying out a vehicle-ramming operation that injured an Israeli soldier. Local sources also reported a raid on Muhammad Ali Al-Muhtaseb Hospital.

The movement said resistance will continue "as long as the occupation persists."
