A Palestinian was killed by Israeli forces in Nablus while new reports point to continued violations of the ceasefire in Gaza.

Local sources say shelling and military operations have not fully stopped despite the agreement remaining in place.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 69,775 and injured 170,965 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.
