Israeli occupation forces continued their campaign of bombing and controlled detonations across Gaza on Saturday, destroying residential buildings and killing at least three people.

The escalation comes amid ongoing violations of the ceasefire, with entire neighborhoods facing renewed demolition operations.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 70,112 and injured 171,015 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

#### 275 Palestinian Children in Israeli Prisons

275 Palestinian children are currently held in Israeli prisons (as of September).

Israel carried out 1,085 child arrests in 2023, including 696 in Jerusalem, the highest annual total.

The detained minors are between 14 and 17 years old, including both pre-trial detainees and children serving harsh sentences.
