Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu chaired a high-level security meeting on Sunday at the Southern Command headquarters on Sunday, as US President Donald Trump publicly called for an immediate ceasefire in Gaza and the return of Israeli captives.

Meanwhile, Al-Qassam and Al-Quds Brigades launch multiple attacks in southern Gaza amid Israeli media blackout and internal military disputes.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 56,531 and injured 133,642 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.
