Turkish Minister Hakan Fidan met with a Hamas delegation in Istanbul to discuss the Gaza ceasefire, during which Hamas submitted a report detailing Israeli violations that have killed hundreds of Palestinians since the agreement's implementation.

Meanwhile, Israeli forces raided several West Bank cities at dawn while illegal Israeli Jewish settlers intensified attacks and land seizures, marking a new escalation in violence across the occupied territory.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 68,865 and injured 170,670 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.
