Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu used his UN address to claim victory in the war with Iran, defend Israel's assault on Gaza, and lash out at Western governments over their recognition of Palestine.

The Al-Qassam Brigades, the armed wing of the Palestinian Resistance Movement Hamas, released footage showing the targeting and destruction of an Israeli Merkava tank that had advanced into the Tel al-Hawa area, south of Gaza City.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 65,549 and injured 167,518 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

Nuseirat Refugee Camp:

Casualties, including deaths and injuries, were reported after an Israeli strike targeted a home belonging to the Al-Jamal family in Camp 5 of the Nuseirat refugee camp in central Gaza.

Continued Shelling:

Israeli forces continue to shell areas with artillery east of Gaza City. Simultaneously, fire was opened from military vehicles east of the Al-Maghazi refugee camp in central Gaza.

Greek Prime Minister Kyriakos Mitsotakis warned Israel that it risks losing its remaining allies due to the war in Gaza. Speaking at the UN General Assembly, Mitsotakis stated that while Israel has the right to self-defense, it "cannot justify the killing of thousands of children," and warned that the current path will "ultimately harm Israel's interests and erode international support."

Financial Coalition for PA:

Twelve countries, including France, the United Kingdom, Japan, Saudi Arabia, and Spain, announced the formation of an emergency coalition to provide direct financial support to the Palestinian Authority (PA).

UN Report Cites 150+ Companies in Settlements; Trump Pushes Gaza Talks Trump Reports "Fruitful" Gaza Talks:

US President Donald Trump stated that "very fruitful discussions" regarding Gaza have been underway for four days with Middle Eastern nations and will continue until a successful agreement is reached. He confirmed that all regional countries are participating and that both Hamas and Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu are fully informed, emphasizing the goal of securing detainees' release and achieving lasting peace.

WSJ: Tony Blair to Govern Gaza Temporarily:

Citing Arab and American officials, The Wall Street Journal reports that Tony Blair is slated to become the interim governor of Gaza under a new Trump administration plan. Blair would head an International Transitional Authority supported by the UN and an Arab-led international force. The

body is intended to manage Gaza for several years, ultimately handing over full control to a team of Palestinian technocrats.

UN Lists 150+ Companies in Settlements:

A report from the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights (OHCHR) identified over 150 companies operating in illegal Israeli settlements in the occupied West Bank, which the UN considers unlawful. The list includes four major online accommodation booking platforms and firms registered in countries like the US, Canada, China, France, and Germany. The report urged these companies to address or remedy any adverse human rights impacts they cause or contribute to.

Support for Israel Declines in US:

A new Quinnipiac University poll, reported by Haaretz, shows a significant drop in US public support for Israel amidst the ongoing genocide. Only 47% of Americans now believe that supporting Israel serves US national interests, down sharply from 69% in December 2023. Conversely, 41% of Americans now believe supporting Israel is contrary to US national interests.
