Meanwhile, Norwegian Foreign Minister Espen Barth Eide has called for an investigation into Israel's attack on aid workers in Rafah.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 50,695Palestinians and injured 115,338 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.
