A source at Al-Shifa Hospital reported that five people were killed and others injured in an Israeli bombardment of the Omar Ibn al-Aas School, which is sheltering displaced persons in the Sheikh Radwan neighborhood, west of Gaza City.

Palestinian media outlets published images showing the recovery of those killed and wounded from the targeted site.

Israeli Ministers Admit Failure in Gaza as Coalition Officials Call for War's End

ISRAELI MEDIA: Israeli ministers are acknowledging setbacks in military operations in Gaza, while Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu is holding security consultations regarding the military situation and prisoners. This comes amidst US statements suggesting significant progress that could lead to a deal ending the war.

Channel 12 reported Wednesday evening that three government ministers stated the war in Gaza holds theoretical concepts but is practically yielding no results. The ministers indicated a need for either further military action or a push to end the war and finalize an agreement.

Channel 12 clarified that Netanyahu still believes a phased plan, such as the one drafted by US envoy to the Middle East Steve Witkoff, is the effective approach.

The ambush in which seven Israeli soldiers were killed by the Al-Qassam Brigades in Khan Yunis has fueled calls in Israel for a deal to end the war and secure the return of Israeli prisoners held in Gaza.

Hamas Calls for Protection Committees to Counter West Bank Settler Attacks

STATEMENT: The Palestinian Resistance Movement Hamas:

The crimes of the occupation and its settlers, the latest of which was in the town of Kafr Malik in the West Bank, necessitate the formation of official and popular protection committees to confront them.

We commend the confrontation by the people of Kafr Malik against the attack by hordes of settlers and the occupation's gangs.

The occupation's crime in Kafr Malik expresses an ingrained approach of the Zionist enemy that aims to kill everything Palestinian.

The occupation's crime in Kafr Malik must not pass unpunished, and our people must confront the occupier and its hordes of settlers with full force.

Our people must strike the settlers at all points of contact in the occupied West Bank.

Our people will not stand idly by in the face of the series of slaughter and displacement, and resistance in all its forms is the natural response to terrorism.

We call on the Palestinian Authority and its security agencies to assume their natural role in protecting our people and providing them with security.

We call on the Palestinian Authority and its security agencies to immediately release all resistance fighters and political detainees they hold.

The Palestinian Ministry of Health announced the killing of three individuals and the injury of 10 others, one in critical condition, during a settler attack on the town of Kafr Malik, northeast of Ramallah.

Local sources reported that dozens of settlers attacked Kafr Malik, burning vehicles and homes. Residents of the town and neighboring villages attempted to confront them. These sources added that Israeli occupation forces provided protection to the settlers and fired live ammunition at Palestinians.

The Israeli army stated that a number of killed and injured individuals fell due to its forces' gunfire. In Jericho, the Palestinian Red Crescent confirmed that 8 people suffered from asphyxiation after settlers set fire to a Palestinian home.

Palestinian platforms have documented scenes showing Israeli soldiers directly firing live ammunition at Palestinians as they confronted the settler attack on Kafr Malik village, northeast of Ramallah.

Seven Killed by Israeli Fire Across Gaza Strip

ISRAELI MEDIA: Seven Palestinians have been killed in separate incidents across the Gaza Strip due to Israeli actions.

In Gaza City, five Palestinians were killed and others injured when an Israeli airstrike hit a school sheltering displaced people in the Sheikh Radwan neighborhood, west of the city, according to sources at Al-Shifa Hospital.

In the central Nuseirat refugee camp, one person was killed and several injured after Israeli occupation forces opened fire on people waiting for aid near the Netzarim axis, with casualties arriving at Al-Awda Hospital.

To the south, a source at Nasser Hospital reported that one person was killed and several injured when an Israeli drone strike hit a tent sheltering displaced individuals in the Al-Mawasi area.

In a statement released Wednesday evening, Abu Obeida, spokesperson for the Izz ad-Din al-Qassam Brigades, praised Palestinian resistance fighters for continuing to display “unique examples of heroism and courage” in confronting Israeli forces.

He described recent ambushes in Gaza as “living historical images” that prove Palestinian fighters are “among the most courageous and self-sacrificing freedom fighters in the modern era.”

Abu Obeida warned that the funerals of Israeli soldiers would become a regular event “so long as the Zionist aggression and criminal war against our people in Gaza continues.”
