Gaza authorities stated that more than 10,000 people killed in the Israeli assault remain buried under the rubble. They called on the international community to allow specialized international rescue teams and heavy equipment into Gaza to recover the bodies.

Meanwhile, on Thursday evening, the Israeli army launched a series of air raids on the towns of Tyre, Taybeh, Aita al-Jabal and Zawtar al-Sharqiyah in southern Lebanon, shortly after warning residents in several areas to evacuate their homes ahead of imminent strikes.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 68,875 and injured 170,679 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

Poll Shows Hamas Leading, Barghouti Leading Abbas

PALESTINIAN POLLING CENTER: A public opinion poll conducted in the West Bank and Gaza found that 60% of Palestinians support Hamas, while 30% support Fatah following the war. The survey also showed that imprisoned Fatah leader Marwan Barghouti would receive 49% of the vote in a presidential election, compared to 13% for Mahmoud Abbas.

The poll indicated that 80% of Palestinians want Abbas to resign.

The National Committee for Missing Persons in the Gaza War stated that more than 10,000 people killed are still buried under the rubble.

The committee called on the world to allow the entry of necessary equipment and provide medical teams to retrieve and identify the remains.

Acute Market Shortages:
