The Khan Yunis Municipality said on Wednesday that everything in Gaza has been destroyed, as Israeli forces continued to violate the ceasefire.

Despite the truce, Israeli air and artillery attacks have persisted across the enclave, leaving no area untouched.

.Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 69,187 and injured 170,703 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

US Submits Revised UN Draft; West Bank Violence Spikes

Revised US Draft Resolution on Gaza at Security Council

Washington distributed a second revised draft resolution to members of the UN Security Council. The draft resolution supports a comprehensive plan to end the war in Gaza and urges all parties to implement it immediately. A specific reference to a path toward self-determination and the establishment of a Palestinian state was added to the revised draft.

UN Coordinator Alarmed by West Bank Settler Violence

The UN Coordinator for Humanitarian Affairs in the Palestinian Territories expressed concern, stating that reports of settlers setting fire to a mosque in the West Bank are troubling. The official noted the incident raises "grave concern" amid rising settler violence and called on Israeli authorities to investigate, hold perpetrators accountable, and protect all individuals.

Rafah Civil Defense Warns of Impending Humanitarian Catastrophe

The Civil Defense in Rafah warned today (Thursday) of an imminent humanitarian catastrophe threatening tens of thousands of displaced persons due to approaching cold weather fronts expected to affect the Strip in the coming days. The Civil Defense indicated that these displaced people are residing in worn-out tents and destroyed homes in the Mawasi, Khan Yunis, and Rafah outskirts, lacking the basic necessities to protect themselves from the cold and rain.

Over 900 Settlers Storm Al-Aqsa Mosque Compound

Palestinian news sites reported that more than 921 settlers stormed the courtyards of Al-Aqsa Mosque today, performing Talmudic rituals under heavy protection from Israeli occupation forces.

Herzog Secretly Promoted Amnesty for Netanyahu

The Israeli newspaper Haaretz revealed that President Isaac Herzog secretly tried to promote an amnesty for Netanyahu even before he was elected president. Herzog reportedly discussed the matter with former President Reuven Rivlin and attempted to arrange a meeting between the two.

Khan Yunis Municipality: Over 900,000 Displaced in Tent City

The spokesman for the Khan Yunis Municipality stated that over 900,000 displaced persons are living in tents in the Mawasi area near the sea. He expressed fear for their safety as a cold weather front approaches and called for pressure on the occupation to allow essential equipment needed for their work to enter the area.

Settlers Assault Palestinian North of West Bank

Palestinian news sites reported that settlers assaulted a citizen near the village of Umm Rihan (near Jenin) in the northern occupied West Bank. The victim was transported to Jenin hospital for treatment.

Axios: Israel Seeks New 20-Year Security Deal with US

The American news website Axios reported, citing Israeli and American officials, that Israel is seeking to conclude a new 20-year security agreement with Washington.

Wall Street Journal: Gaza War a ‘Huge Deal’ for US Corporations

The Wall Street Journal reported that the war in Gaza has been a “huge deal” for American corporations. US companies have achieved billions of dollars in sales to Israel, with Washington approving over \$32 billion in arms sales since October 2023—a significant doubling of usual military aid. The report notes this surge created an unprecedented supply line of American weapons to Israel, guaranteeing continuous profits, with the financial burden borne by American taxpayers.
