Israeli forces continued lethal strikes across the Gaza Strip, leaving scores killed and wounded in multiple areas as bombardment and drone fire intensified overnight.

At the same time, raids, detentions, and armed incursions expanded across the occupied West Bank, adding to growing fears that the violence will widen even further.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 69,483 and injured 170,706 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

The recent agreement enabled us to return almost all 'hostages,' and there are still 3 dead bodies we are working to return.

We have not yet finished the first phase and continue to work on recovering the last 3 bodies.

The transition to the second phase of the agreement is linked to exhausting the available information about the recovery of the bodies.

The main mission, as defined by the UN Security Council resolution and the Trump plan, is to dismantle Hamas and disarm the Gaza Strip.

Washington wants to test the deployment of an international force in Gaza, and we told them they can try, but time is not open-ended.
