Israel continues to violate the ceasefire agreement with repeated strikes and ground incursions across the Gaza Strip.

Meanwhile, a draft resolution circulated at the United Nations signals international support for the Trump administration's stabilization plan for Gaza, prompting sharp criticism from Palestinian political and civil society groups.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 69,182 and injured 170,694 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

Haaretz: 704 Settler Attacks on Palestinians by October

ISRAELI MEDIA: Haaretz reported, citing Israeli security establishment data, a sharp increase in settler attacks on Palestinians in the occupied West Bank, resulting in 174 Palestinians injured since the start of the year.

The army recorded 704 settler attacks up to October 2025, compared to 675 attacks in all of 2024 — nearly 70 attacks per month.

The report stated that police and the Shin Bet did not intervene due to pressure from government ministers and Knesset members.

The ministry added that limited medical capacity and lack of assistive devices are worsening the suffering of amputees, noting that 6,000 recorded cases require urgent long-term rehabilitation programs.

Three Palestinians Killed in Gaza Within 24 Hours

GAZA HEALTH MINISTRY:

The Gaza Ministry of Health announced that three Palestinians and one injured person arrived at hospitals in the past 24 hours as a result of Israeli fire.

Since the ceasefire began, 245 Palestinians have been killed and 623 injured, while rescue teams have recovered 529 bodies from under the rubble.

This raises the total number of Palestinians killed to 69,182 and injured to 170,694 since October 2023.

Israeli Budget Deficit Peaks as Revenues Collapse and Spending Rises

ISRAELI MEDIA: A report in Calcalist showed that Israel's financial deficit increased to 4.9% of GDP in October, up from 4.7% in September, due to rising government spending and declining revenues. The total deficit reached 102.5 billion shekels (about \$31.3 billion) over the past 12 months.
