The Gaza government media office reported that over 50 people were killed or went missing after an Israeli airstrike hit a house in Jabaliya al-Balad, northern Gaza.

Meanwhile, UN agencies warned that the aid entering Gaza remains insufficient, as famine continues to spread in the besieged Strip. In central Gaza's Deir al-Balah, Israeli forces also killed six aid workers.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 53,822 and injured 122,382 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

The move came just one day after Israel's Supreme Court ruled Bar's dismissal as "inappropriate and contrary to the law," and has been widely interpreted within Israel as a challenge to the judiciary.
