Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 69,775 and injured 170,965 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

Death Toll of Genocide War in Gaza Rises to 69,785

MEDICAL SOURCES: Medical sources announced that the death toll in the Gaza Strip has risen to 69,785, the majority of whom are children and women, since the start of the Israeli occupation's aggression on October 7, 2023.

Medical sources, quoted by the Palestinian News Agency, clarified that the number of injured rose to 170,965, while a number of victims remain under the rubble, and ambulance and rescue crews cannot reach them.

They noted that 10 martyrs reached Gaza Strip hospitals in the past 24 hours, including 2 new martyrs and 8 whose bodies were recovered.

The total number of martyrs and injured since the ceasefire agreement on October 10 is 347 martyrs and 889 injured, and 596 bodies have been recovered.
