Prisoners' Media Office: Abdullah Barghouti Subjected to Severe Torture

PALESTINIAN PRISONERS' OFFICE: The Palestinian Prisoners' Media Office said prisoner Abdullah Barghouti, serving 67 life sentences, is subjected to severe physical and psychological torture at Gilboa Prison. The office said Barghouti has been repeatedly beaten by guards

accompanied by dogs, causing deep wounds, fractures, and untreated bone injuries, describing the situation as an attempt at “slow execution.”
