Sources in Gaza hospitals report that 35 Palestinians were killed by Israeli occupation forces in several areas across the Strip on Wednesday morning. Among the victims, 25 were civilians waiting for aid near the Netzarim axis.

Meanwhile, Israeli media report that Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu is exerting significant pressure on Haredi parties to dissuade them from supporting the Knesset dissolution bill.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 55,104 and injured 127,394 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.
