Gaza hospitals reported that over 100 Palestinians were killed since dawn, as Israel escalates its assault on Gaza City with raids, bombardments, and ground incursions.

Meanwhile, Ansarallah's military spokesman said they carried out a military operation with a hypersonic ballistic missile targeting a sensitive Israeli site in Jaffa, while drones targeted Ramon Airport in Umm al-Rashrash.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 65,062 and injured 165,697 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

## **News Roundup: Israeli Violence in Gaza and West Bank**

### **Casualties and Airstrikes:**

Medical sources in Gaza hospitals report that 12 Palestinians have been killed by Israeli fire since dawn today, with seven of the victims in Gaza City.

In southern Gaza, an Israeli strike on a displaced persons' tent in Mawasi Khan Yunis killed three members of the same family.

Local sources also reported a series of Israeli airstrikes on the eastern parts of Gaza City.

### **Demolitions and Explosions:**

A local source stated that Israeli forces detonated booby-trapped robots near the Sheikh Radwan pond in northwestern Gaza City.

An Al Jazeera correspondent also reported that the Israeli army is carrying out building demolition operations in southern Gaza City.

### **European Union Stance:**

The European Union's Foreign Policy Chief, Kaja Kallas, stated that an Israeli ground offensive on Gaza would mean more death, destruction, and displacement.

### **West Bank Raids:**

Local Palestinian sources report that Israeli forces are continuing their incursion into the Khallet al-Amoud neighborhood in Nablus, in the northern West Bank, conducting raids and arrests.

### **UK on Israeli Entry Ban:**

Britain's Minister of State for the Middle East stated that Israel's decision to prevent two British MPs from entering the occupied Palestinian territories is unacceptable.

## **News Roundup: International Condemnation and Escalating Attacks in Gaza**

### **Airstrikes and Demolitions:**

An Israeli airstrike on a home in the Nuseirat refugee camp killed a Palestinian man, his wife, and their daughter.

In the Tal al-Hawa neighborhood, a strike on a residential apartment killed two Palestinians and wounded others.

Separately, Israeli aircraft bombed a residential tower east of Nuseirat camp.

Local sources also reported that Israeli forces are carrying out demolitions of residential buildings near the Sheikh Radwan pond in northern Gaza.

### **Booby-trapped vehicles:**

Israeli forces reportedly detonated an armored vehicle packed with explosives to demolish homes in the southern part of the Tal al-Hawa neighborhood.

### **Aid Agencies:**

More than 20 aid agencies have signed a letter to the United Nations, urging world leaders to take immediate action to end what the genocide in Gaza. The agencies stated that the "militarization of the aid system" in Gaza is deadly, noting that thousands are being shot while trying to access aid. They warn that Gaza will face its deadliest period in history if no action is taken.

### **Canadian Foreign Ministry:**

The Canadian Foreign Ministry called the Israeli ground offensive on Gaza "horrific," stating that it worsens the humanitarian crisis and threatens the release of hostages.

Canada called for an immediate and permanent ceasefire, unrestricted aid delivery, and the release of all hostages.

The ministry also affirmed that the Israeli government must abide by international law.

### **Norwegian Refugee Council:**

The Norwegian Refugee Council said that the findings of the UN Commission of Inquiry on genocide in Gaza reflect the suffering of their colleagues on the ground. The council stressed that international law is clear and requires the protection of civilians, the delivery of aid, and an end to the genocide.

### **Irish President:**

Irish President Michael D. Higgins stated that Israel and the countries that supply it with weapons should be excluded from the United Nations. He argued that the international community should no longer hesitate to end trade with the “perpetrators of these crimes against our fellow human beings.” He also criticized some of the most powerful EU countries for their silence regarding the “humanitarian tragedy” faced by the people of Gaza.

### **Oxfam:**

The head of humanitarian affairs for the organization Oxfam told Al-Jazeera that Israel is not granting the organization permits to bring aid into Gaza.
