The Israeli military reported that a sixth wave of Iranian missiles was launched toward Israel at dawn today, killing at least three people and wounding 172.

Meanwhile, at least 27 Palestinians have been killed in Gaza by Israeli occupation forces since dawn on Saturday.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 55,297 and injured 128,426 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

Al-Qassam Announces New Operation

According to the group, two Israeli armored personnel carriers were damaged using explosive devices, including a Shuath-type and a guerrilla device. Fighters then reportedly engaged the soldiers at close range, resulting in the death of one.

When an Israeli rescue team arrived, it was targeted with pre-planted explosives, resulting in additional casualties. Al-Qassam reported observing helicopters landing at the scene to evacuate the wounded.
