Israeli National Security Minister Itamar Ben-Gvir issued a direct threat to the imprisoned Palestinian leader Marwan Barghouti after storming his cell at Ganot Prison, which was formerly known as Ramon and Nafha Prisons.

Meanwhile, families of Israeli captives in Gaza announced that Israel will come to a standstill next Sunday as massacres across the Strip continued.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 61,827 and injured 155,275 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

#### More Than 61,000 Killed in Gaza since Start of Genocide

GAZA HEALTH MINISTRY: The Israeli offensive has killed 61,827 people and wounded 155,275 others since October 7, 2023. Between March 18 and today alone, 10,300 Palestinians were killed and 43,234 wounded. The number of "bread seekers" killed while attempting to obtain aid has risen to 1,898, with more than 14,113 injured. The ministry also confirmed the death of a child due to famine, bringing starvation-related fatalities to 240, including 107 children.

#### **UN Condemns Smotrich's Settlement Plan**

## Al-Qassam Claims Ambush in Southern Gaza City

STATEMENT: The Al-Qassam Brigades stated:

On Wednesday, we carried out a complex ambush against an Israeli force south of the Al-Zaytoun neighborhood in southern Gaza City, targeting its members with a shell and machine guns.

During the ambush, we targeted two armored personnel carriers with two explosive devices placed inside the cockpit.

We also targeted a "Nimr" type armored personnel carrier with a "Yassin 105" shell.

Our fighters, while withdrawing from the ambush site, targeted two houses where occupation soldiers were fortified with shells.

Our fighters confirmed that they had inflicted casualties among the occupation soldiers, leaving them dead or wounded.
