# UN Experts Recommend Arms Embargo on Israel and Dismantling of 'Gaza Foundation'

AL-JAZEERA: UN experts have recommended that member states impose a comprehensive arms embargo on Israel due to its multiple violations of international law. They also called for the immediate dismantling of the "Gaza Humanitarian Foundation," asserting that it is carrying out "military and geopolitical objectives" under the guise of aid distribution.

In a report published today, Tuesday, the experts stated that Palestinians are paying the price for the international community's legal, political, and moral failure. They emphasized that preventing or delaying aid is a war crime aimed at starving civilians in the context of documented and condemned genocide.

The experts added that the sight of children dying of starvation in their parents' arms should shake us and pull us out of inaction.

60,000 pregnant women suffer from severe anemia, general weakness, and an increased risk of bleeding.

We have recorded cases of congenital deformities as a result of the tragic conditions in which the strip and its people live.
