UNRWA stated that the only way to prevent the worsening of the current catastrophe in Gaza is to ensure the effective and continuous flow of humanitarian aid, with 500 to 600 trucks entering the Strip daily.

Meanwhile, the Al-Qassam Brigades announced that they had killed and wounded a group of Israeli soldiers by detonating a house rigged with highexplosive devices in the town of Al-Qarara, east of Khan Yunis.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 53,939 and injured 122,797 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

Israel Warns against Unilateral Recognition of Palestinian State

ISRAELI MEDIA: Israel Hayom reported that the Foreign Minister warned major countries that any unilateral recognition of a Palestinian state would be met with the imposition of sovereignty over the West Bank. They added that unilateral steps against Israel would be met with unilateral steps from its side.

WHO: Crowding Around Aid Trucks Caused by Israel

AL-JAZEERA:

The spokesperson for the World Health Organization told Al Jazeera that hospitals in Gaza are operating only partially due to a severe shortage of medical staff.

"We need to open the crossings to allow the entry and distribution of humanitarian aid," they emphasized.

The spokesperson stressed the urgent need for a ceasefire in the Gaza Strip, adding, "There is no need for an alternative aid plan—we need a political decision to open the gates for humanitarian relief, free from political considerations."

They concluded by holding Israel responsible for the worsening humanitarian crisis: "The crowding of people around aid trucks is a direct result of Israeli policies."

Poll: 70% of Gaza Envelope Residents Concerned Economically

ISRAELI MEDIA: A poll by the Israeli National Forum found that only 24.3% of residents in the Gaza envelope decided to return to their homes after the events of October 7, 2023. Additionally, 12.6% of Gaza envelope residents stated they would not return to their homes, and 42.4% were unsure. The poll also revealed that 70% of Gaza envelope residents feel increasing economic anxiety in the aftermath of the war.

Clash Between Finance Ministry and Military Over Expenses

ISRAELI MEDIA: The Israeli Broadcasting Authority reported a clash between the Ministry of Finance and the military establishment due to increased expenses for expanding fighting in Gaza. Finance Minister Smotrich reportedly reprimanded the security establishment over the high costs of expanding fighting during a meeting chaired by Netanyahu. The army's expenses have exceeded its budget by \$4 billion at this stage of the year.

REUTERS: Reuters quoted German Foreign Minister Johann Wadephul saying: "We are deeply concerned about the unbearable humanitarian suffering in Gaza." He added, "No to the expulsion of Palestinians from Gaza, and we call for an end to hunger in the Strip." He affirmed that "the Gaza Strip and the West Bank are Palestinian on a path leading to a two-state solution."

Al-Quds Brigades Target Israeli Vehicles in Explosive Ambush in Sheja'iyya

PALESTINE CHRONICLE: The Al-Quds Brigades, the military wing of the Islamic Jihad movement, released footage reportedly showing a complex ambush targeting Israeli occupation forces that had advanced into the Sheja'iyya neighborhood, east of Gaza City.

According to the group, their fighters carried out a sophisticated engineering operation, detonating a bomb left behind by Israeli forces along with a penetrating explosive device, striking Israeli military vehicles operating in the area.

UNRWA: The Director of the Media Office for the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA) in Gaza stated that there is no need for new aid delivery mechanisms in Gaza. The director emphasized that the proposed new aid plan is inconsistent with humanitarian principles and does not guarantee fair distribution of aid to Gaza residents. UNRWA reiterated the necessity for 500 to 600 aid trucks to enter Gaza daily to resolve the crisis.
