# **Abu Marzouk: We Accepted Egyptian Proposal, Trump Plan Requires Negotiations**

HAMAS OFFICIAL MOUSA ABU MARZOUK (to Al-Jazeera):

"We accepted a regional and international framework proposed by Egypt that includes answers regarding peace and the future. We will hand over weapons to the future Palestinian state, and whoever governs Gaza will control the arms.

We accepted President Donald Trump's plan in principle, in its main outlines, but its implementation requires negotiations. We value the Arab, Islamic, and international efforts, as well as President Trump's role in halting the war, facilitating prisoner exchanges, and ensuring immediate aid entry.

The US must take a positive approach toward the future of the Palestinian people. The plan cannot be implemented without negotiations. The issues relevant to Hamas in Trump's plan were addressed positively. Hamas is a national liberation movement, and the definition of terrorism in the plan cannot be applied to it.

All details regarding peacekeeping forces require understandings and clarifications. The priority is to stop the war and massacres, and from this perspective we dealt positively with the plan.

The idea of handing over prisoners and bodies within 72 hours is theoretical and unrealistic under current circumstances. We will enter negotiations on all matters related to the movement and weapons.

We reached a national consensus to hand over the administration of Gaza to independents, with the Palestinian Authority as the reference. Shaping the future of the Palestinian people is a national issue that Hamas cannot decide alone."

## Hamas Leader: Response to Trump Plan 'Will Not Be Delayed,' Rejects Threats

Mohammad Nazzal, a member of the Political Bureau of Hamas, stated that the movement will announce its position on the US plan "very soon" and publicly.

Speaking to Al-Jazeera, Nazzal made the following points:

**Timing of Response:** He confirmed that Hamas's response "will not be delayed" and will take into account the interests of the Palestinian people, core strategic principles, and political considerations, emphasizing the urgency of stopping the genocide.

**Rejection of Coercion:** Nazzal stressed that Hamas is serious about reaching understandings based on stopping the war and genocide in Gaza, but it "does not accept the logic of threats, dictations, and pressures being exerted like a sword of Damocles."

**Seeking Common Ground:** He confirmed that Hamas received the plan — attributed to US President Donald Trump — last Monday evening. While stating the plan has "many reservations," he noted that the movement is looking for "grey areas" to achieve a halt to the genocide in Gaza.

**Commitment:** Nazzal reiterated Hamas's commitment to reaching understandings, prioritizing the cessation of massacres before the conflict enters its third year, and affirmed that the immense sacrifices of the Palestinian people cannot end in the forfeiture of their rights. He concluded that Hamas accepts the logic of dialogue and discussion.
