Israeli occupation forces released Dr. Muhammad Abu Salamiya, director of the Al-Shifa Medical Complex, who was arrested on November 23 during the first invasion of the hospital.

Extraordinary security consultations were launched on Sunday evening in the southern region of Israel, headed by Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, with the participation of Defense Minister Yoav Gallant, the Army Chief of Staff, and senior leaders of the security services.

Israeli forces carried out relentless airstrikes and artillery bombing, targeting several areas throughout the Gaza Strip.

According to Gaza's Ministry of Health, 37,900 Palestinians have been killed, and 87,060 wounded in Israel's ongoing genocide in Gaza starting on October 7.

## **LATEST UPDATES**

**Tuesday, July 2, 01:20 am (GMT+2)**

**PALESTINIAN MEDIA:** Several Palestinians were injured as a result of the Israeli occupation forces targeting the Abu Jalala family home northwest of the Nuseirat camp in the central Gaza Strip early Tuesday.

**AL-JAZEERA:** The Israeli army carried out air strikes and artillery shelling tonight on the northern part of the Nuseirat camp in the central Gaza Strip.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Evacuation of the European Gaza Hospital south of Khan Yunis after Israeli orders to evacuate the eastern areas of the city.

PALINFO: Palestinian news websites quoted Israeli media tonight as saying that there is a state of alert in the Israeli Air Force as a result of what it described as a “complex event” in the Netzarim axis in the Gaza Strip, in reference to a possible resistance operation that may have resulted in deaths and injuries among Israeli soldiers.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Three Palestinians were killed when the Israeli army bombed the home of the “Breikh” family in the Customs Police neighborhood in Khan Yunis, south of the Gaza Strip.

**Monday, July 1, 11:00 pm (GMT+2)**

AL-QASSAM BRIGADES: Our fighters targeted a “Zionist Merkava tank with a ‘Yassin 105’ shell on Jerusalem Street in the Tel Al-Sultan neighborhood west of Rafah city” in the southern Gaza Strip.

AL-JAZEERA: Several Palestinians were killed and wounded as a result of Israeli shelling that targeted a house in the Nuseirat camp in the central Gaza Strip.

KAN: Within 5 days, a sniper squad commander and a soldier were killed and 17 were injured by explosive devices in Tulkarm and Jenin.

ISRAELI ARMY: The occupation army announces the death of a soldier and the serious injury of another in the detonation of an explosive device during the storming of the Nour Shams camp this morning.

BEN-GVIR: The Shin Bet chief Ronen Bar threatened him a week ago that he would release Palestinian prisoners if their detention conditions did not improve. Ben Gvir noted that the head of the Shin Bet “is harming Israel’s security, to cause harm to me.

CHANNEL 12: Hamas is recruiting hundreds of new militants, recovering well, rehabilitating hospitals and paying salaries to its members.

KAN: The political level agrees to move to the final phase of the war during the current month.

**Monday, July 1, 9:15 pm (GMT+2)**

KAN: All detainees from Gaza were transferred to the Sde Teiman detention center.

HEZBOLLAH: Our fighters targeted buildings used by occupation soldiers in the Granot HaGalil settlement with appropriate weapons and achieved a direct hit.

US STATE DEPARTMENT: Restoring calm to the Israeli-Lebanese border is our priority.

HEZBOLLAH: Our fighters targeted buildings used by occupation soldiers in the Kfar Giladi settlement and achieved a direct hit.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Five Palestinians were killed and 10 others were injured in an Israeli bombardment on Al-JalaA Street, west of Gaza City.

NETANYAHU: Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu considered the release of the director of Al-Shifa Hospital a grave mistake and a moral failure, and that this decision was taken without the knowledge of the political level.

**Monday, July 1, 8:00 pm (GMT+2)**

MAYOR OF SDEROT: Netanyahu, Gallant, and Halevy are repeating the same mistake that led to last October 7. Netanyahu solves the problem by creating a new problem, and we will not agree to more temporary solutions.

CHANNEL 13: Seven rockets were fired from Lebanon and fell in open areas in Upper Galilee, northern Israel.

AL-JAZEERA: One person was killed in Israeli artillery shelling that targeted homes east of Al-Bureij camp in the central Gaza Strip.

NETANYAHU: We are close to eliminating Hamas' capabilities.

**Monday, July 1, 6:30 pm (GMT+2)**

ISRAELI ARMY: The Israeli army announced the start of the evacuation of residents from the area east of Khan Yunis after about 20 rockets were fired from the area towards the Gaza envelope.

BLINKEN: We engaged in diligent efforts with Egypt and Qatar to advance Biden's proposal.

ISRAELI MEDIA: More than 800 officers with the rank of colonel and lieutenant colonel have submitted their resignations this year, an almost unprecedented rate.

CHANNEL 12: Five rockets fired from Lebanon fell in open areas in Ma'ayan Baruch.

AL-JAZEERA: A person was killed in an Israeli bombardment on the town of Al-Fakhari, east of Khan Yunis.

AL-QUDS BRIGADES: Our fighters bombed the Israeli occupation army command headquarters in the Amitai military base near the Kerem Shalom site with 107 missiles.

HEZBOLLAH: We targeted a building used by occupation soldiers in the Ramot Naftali settlement, and achieved a direct hit.

**Monday, July 1, 5:30 pm (GMT+2)**

CHANNEL 12: Shells were fired from Lebanon and hit a house in Metula without warning.

AL-QUDS BRIGADES: Our fighters targeted a Zionist Merkava tank with an RPG shell and clashed with soldiers at the same location southwest of the city of Rafah.

AL-JAZEERA: Sirens sounded in Ramot Naftali in the Upper Galilee for fear of launching rocket shells from Lebanon.

**Monday, July 1, 4:30 pm (GMT+2)**

SMOTRICH: Only military rule in Gaza will allow the occupation and control of the Strip and prevent the return of Hamas.

ISRAELI ARMY RADIO: A house in Metulla was hit by a missile fired from Lebanon, without activating the sirens.

UNRWA: Humanitarian response is “impossible” in Gaza.

FREED PRISONER FARAJ AL-SAMUNI:

I was subjected to the most horrific methods of torture during my interrogation by the Israeli army.

My torture methods were not limited to the physical aspect, but also included psychological torture.

ISRAELI ARMY: The Israeli army acknowledged the killing of a soldier and the injury of another from the Nahal Brigade in battles in the southern Gaza Strip.

HAMAS: The condition of the released prisoners confirms the occupation’s criminal behavior.

**Monday, July 1, 3:00 pm (GMT+2)**

AL-JAZEERA: An Israeli drone raided the town of Markaba in southern Lebanon.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: A young man was killed and others were injured in an Israeli bombing that targeted the Musabah area, north of the city of Rafah, in the southern Gaza Strip.

WSJ (citing Israeli military official): The military operation in the Shujaiya neighborhood east of Gaza City aims to prevent the Islamic Resistance Movement (Hamas) from reorganizing its ranks there.

BEN-GVIR: The dispute between him and the Shin Bet is not about the existence of detention facilities in prisons but rather about the Shin Bet’s desire to improve the conditions of Palestinian detainees or release them.

LAPID: Netanyahu’s government opposed the deal and will now stop the war without returning the detainees.

AL-QASSAM BRIGADES: Our fighters blew up an Israeli Merkava 4 tank with two “command action” devices, south of Al-Tayaran Street in the Tal Al-Sultan neighborhood in the city of Rafah, south of the Gaza Strip.

GALLANT: The Israeli army needs 10,000 additional soldiers for the army immediately.

**Monday, July 1, 2:00 pm (GMT+2)**

PALESTINIAN MEDIA:

Two Palestinians were injured in an Israeli bombardment that targeted a civilian car in the town of Bani Suhaila, east of Khan Yunis, in the southern Gaza Strip.

A young man was killed and others were injured in Israeli artillery shelling that targeted the northern areas of the Nuseirat camp in the central Gaza Strip.

AL-QASSAM BRIGADES: Our fighters targeted two Israeli Merkava tanks with two Shawaaz bombs in the Shuja'iyya neighborhood, east of Gaza City.

GAZA HEALTH MINISTRY: 37,900 Palestinians have been killed, and 87,060 wounded in Israel's ongoing genocide in Gaza starting on October 7.

**Monday, July 1, 1:00 pm (GMT+2)**

GAZA GOVERNMENT MEDIA OFFICE: The office announced the martyrdom of journalist Muhammad Abu Sharia in an Israeli bombing, bringing the death toll of journalists to 153 since October 7.

AL-QUDS BRIGADES: We shelled Israeli soldiers and vehicles that had penetrated the Shejaiya neighborhood east of Gaza City with mortar shells, amid ongoing fighting in the area.

ISRAELI MEDIA: There were injuries and possibly deaths among Israeli soldiers after the bombing of a building booby-trapped by the resistance in Rafah, south of the Gaza Strip, after the Al-Qassam Brigades said that they had blown up a house with Israeli force in Rafah.

**Monday, July 1, 12:00 pm (GMT+2)**

CHANNEL 12: Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu is angry because he and Defense Minister Yoav Gallant learned from the media about the release of the director of the Shifa Medical Complex, Muhammad Abu Salamiya.

AL-JAZEERA: Two young men were killed and others were injured by an Israeli artillery shelling that targeted the town of Khuza'a, east of the city of Khan Yunis, in the southern Gaza Strip.

GALLANT: The release of security prisoners is within the authority of the Shin Bet and the Prison Service.

NETANYAHU: The decision to release the Palestinian prisoners came after discussions in the Supreme Court regarding a petition against their detention in the Sde Teman camp in the Negev.

LAPID: Accusations about Abu Salmiya's release are a government dysfunction.

YEDIOTH AHRONOTH (citing a military source): The army found during the operation in the Shejaiya neighborhood east of Gaza City that Hamas was able to rehabilitate itself militarily and financially.

GANTZ: Releasing those who provided sponsorship to the killers on October 7 and helped hide our kidnappers is an operational and moral mistake.

AL-JAZEERA: Israeli artillery shelled the areas of Al-Maghraqa, Al-Zahraa, and northern Al-Nuseirat, north of the central governorate in the besieged Gaza Strip.

MOHAMMED ABU SALMIYA: Israeli doctors and nurses beat and torture Palestinian prisoners and treat the bodies of detainees as if they were inanimate objects.

AL-JAZEERA: Dozens of Palestinians have flocked since the morning to Al-Aqsa Martyrs Hospital in Deir Al-Balah in the central Gaza Strip, after the occupation authorities released 50 prisoners who had been arrested in the past months.

**Monday, July 1, 11:00 am (GMT+2)**

GALLANT: I did not know about the decision to release the director of Al-Shifa Hospital.

AL-JAZEERA: A young Palestinian man was killed and others were injured in Israeli artillery shelling of the town of Khuza'a, east of Khan Yunis, in the southern Gaza Strip.

AL-QASSAM BRIGADES: We blew up a booby-trapped house with an Israeli force.

**Monday, July 1, 10:00 am (GMT+2)**

ISRAELI MEDIA: Israeli National Security Minister Itamar Ben Gvir described the release of the director of the Al-Shifa Medical Complex, Muhammad Abu Salamiya, as "security negligence."

KAN: Israel released the director of the Shifa Complex because the prisons were full

AL-QUDS BRIGADES: We bombed the settlements surrounding Gaza.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Israeli warplanes carried out a raid at dawn today on the Grand Mosque, which it had previously targeted in the Bureij refugee camp in the central Gaza Strip.

**Monday, July 1, 05:00 am (GMT+2)**

AL-AQSA TV: The Israeli army shelled the center and west of Rafah city in the southern Gaza Strip at dawn on Monday.

**Monday, July 1, 04:00 am (GMT+2)**

AL-JAZEERA: The Israeli occupation army carried out artillery shelling on areas in the Al-Shuja'iya and Al-Tuffah neighborhoods in Gaza City at dawn on Monday.

**Monday, July 1, 03:00 am (GMT+2)**

AL-AQSA TV: A number of Palestinians were injured early Monday as a result of a bomb explosion dropped by an Israeli drone on the vicinity of the Islamic Complex Mosque in the Al-Sabra neighborhood in Gaza City.

**Monday, July 1, 02:00 am (GMT+2)**

ISLAMIC RESISTANCE IN IRAQ: The Islamic Resistance in Iraq announced early Monday that it had attacked, with drones, a vital target in the Israeli city of Eilat on the Red Sea.

HAMAS: Using detainees in Gaza as human shields is a war crime.

**Monday, July 1, 01:00 am (GMT+2)**

AL-AQSA TV: An Israeli drone opened fire tonight in the vicinity of the “Bastat Market” in the Shuja’iyya neighborhood, east of Gaza City.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Several explosions were heard tonight in the Nuseirat camp in the central Gaza Strip.
