Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 64,756 and injured 164,059 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

## **65 Killed by Israeli Fire since Dawn**

The number of deaths caused by starvation has reached 413, including 143 children.

## **Latest from the Gaza Genocide**

### **Airstrikes and Casualties:**

An Israeli airstrike on a home in the Al-Tawam area in northern Gaza City killed 14 Palestinians.

Elsewhere, in Khan Yunis and Rafah, a Palestinian was killed by Israeli fire and another was killed by occupation forces near an aid distribution center.

Airstrikes also caused plumes of thick smoke and widespread destruction in several neighborhoods across Gaza City.

### **Humanitarian Crisis:**

The UNRWA stated that civilians in Gaza are trapped with no safe place to go, facing harsh conditions and increasing food insecurity. The agency called for a ceasefire before it is too late.

UNICEF reported that malnutrition rates among children are rising at an alarming pace, with a record 13.5% of children screened in August suffering from acute malnutrition.

### **Other Developments:**

A security source from the Palestinian resistance told Al-Jazeera that “gangs of collaborators and undercover agents” have recently kidnapped several resistance fighters in the Gaza Strip. The source said that the resistance will “pursue and show no mercy to them.”
