Sirens sounded across Israel as Yemeni armed forces, affiliated with the Ansarallah movement, launched a missile in solidarity with Gaza.

Meanwhile, despite Israeli claims of a 'slowdown' in operations, bombardments on Gaza continued, killing and wounding displaced people in their tents and civilians waiting for aid.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 67,074 and injured 169,430 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.
