At least 11 Israelis were killed in major Palestinian Resistance operations in Jerusalem and Jabaliya, while Yemen's Ansarallah launched more drones towards Israel.

Meanwhile, Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu said that Israeli forces had demolished 50 high-rise "terror towers" in Gaza in just two days, declaring it a prelude to a major ground assault into Gaza City.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 64,605 and injured 163,319 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

US officials reportedly witnessed the missiles being launched and deduced the target from the launch. The commander of US Central Command learned of the attack while en route to Cairo.

ISRAELI ARMY: The Israeli army ordered the full evacuation of all neighborhoods in Gaza City, directing residents toward Al-Mawasi via Al-Rashid corridor. Simultaneously, the army is carrying out widescale demolitions of multi-story buildings to forcibly displace civilians.

Civil Defense: Five Towers Hit in 72 Hours

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Gaza's Civil Defense reported that Israeli forces bombed five high-rise buildings in 72 hours, containing 209 apartments. The destruction displaced over 4,100 children, women, and elderly people, and destroyed more than 350 tents, leaving nearly 3,500 people without shelter.

ISRAELI ARMY: The Israeli army confirmed that a lieutenant was killed in operations in Jabalia on Monday. Meanwhile, Al-Qassam Brigades announced its "Moses' Staff" operations targeting Israeli forces, tanks, and equipment, particularly in Gaza City's Al-Zaytoun neighborhood and Jabaliya in the north.

Israeli Airstrikes Target Military Sites in Syria

ANADOLU/AJA: Israeli airstrikes have hit several military sites in Syria, including locations near Homs and Latakia. The Syrian Foreign Ministry condemned the attacks and called on the UN Security Council to intervene.

An Al-Jazeera correspondent, citing local Syrian sources, reported that Israeli airstrikes tonight targeted the Air Defense College near the city of Homs and a military barracks in Saqoubin, north of Latakia.

According to the Turkish Anadolu Agency, Israeli warplanes also carried out a raid near the city of Palmyra in central Syria.

The Syrian Foreign Ministry condemned the attacks, calling them a blatant violation of Syria's sovereignty and a threat to its regional security and stability. The ministry called on the UN Security Council to take a firm stance to end Israel's repeated attacks.

Saif Abu Kashk, the official spokesperson for the Flotilla of Resilience, told Al Jazeera that the fleet will not be deterred and will continue its journey despite the attack it was subjected to at the Sidi Bou Said port in the Tunisian capital.

The UN Special Rapporteur, Francesca Albanese, and the management of the Flotilla of Resilience have condemned a drone attack on a key ship off the coast of Tunisia.

Francesca Albanese, the UN Special Rapporteur, described the targeting of the flotilla's main ship as "dangerous" and stated that she awaits the results of an investigation. She urged the other flotilla ships heading to Tunisia to exercise caution, noting that two of the vessels are in transit and require urgent protection.

Thiago Ávila, a member of the flotilla's management, told Al Jazeera that the ship, the "Family," was targeted by an incendiary drone off the coast of Tunisia. He confirmed that members of their team were on board at the time of the attack, but all of them survived.

Gaza News Roundup

Flotilla Attack:

According to the management of the Flotilla of Resilience, one of its main ships, the “Family,” was attacked by a drone off the coast of Tunisia. The committee has advised the flotilla not to proceed to the port of Sidi Bou Said in the Tunisian capital after a fire was detected on board the vessel.

West Bank Incursions:

Israeli forces raided several locations in the occupied West Bank, including the village of Deir Jarir near Ramallah, the village of Beit Awwa, and the cities of Nablus and Tulkarm. Forces also entered the refugee camps of Balata and Askar. Israeli forces entered the home of a prisoner in Beit Awwa, south of Hebron, in preparation for its demolition.

Hamas Accusations:

Hamas has called Netanyahu’s demand for Gaza residents to leave their homes an “open practice of forced displacement,” accusing the UN and the Security Council of double standards and complicity with Washington.

Hostage Families’ Appeal:
